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This dual degree in Law and Management is a five-year studies programme, which remains unique in France and allows students to gain multidisciplinary competencies associated with a strong analytical capacity, rigor, critical analysis and synthesis. With this programme, the Faculty of Law and IESEG train tomorrow's professionals to be able to serve interdisciplinary functions in the domains of Human Resources, Law, or Finance and become Lawyers, legal practitioners, Directors of Human Resources, or Directors of Finance, all in an international environment. Courses are taught in French and in English and students must complete a mandatory six-month university exchange abroad. In addition, the 12 months of internships, which students must complete during the five years of the programme, allow them to gain significant experience before entering the labour market.

STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAMME IN 5 YEARS

During the five-year programme, students take courses in Law, Management, languages, enroll on seminars aiming to their personal and professional development, complete internships and essays in order to earn the dual degree:

Master of Law, Economics, Business Management from the Faculty of Law (FLD) and the "Grand Ecole" master from IESEG

At the end of the third year, students are granted a Bachelor of Law, Economics and Business Management from the Faculty of Law (FLD).
